<u>Views of NFTE</u> Shri Chandeshwar Singh, General Secy vide his rep. No TF-01 dated 2.8.2017 says, "Some circles using their own interpretation are explaining that only unwilling female employees who are going to complete 55 years of age will be exempted. " According to NFTE para 'f' of letter No 6-1/2007-Restg Vol-II dated 22.1.2016 should be explained as "all unwilling female employees and other employees completing 55 years of age on 31 st March of financial year are to be exempted from transfer."	 Posting of all unwilling female employees (whatsoever their age) and all other employees (including male employees) completing 55 years of age as on 31 st March of the financial year to rural / unpopular stations will be avoided as far as possible.
